The Aspen Institute Germany will hold its second annual Berlin AI conference at the Baden-Württemberg Representation in Berlin on March 28-9, 2019. It will bring together 200-250 selected high-level guests for discussions that will take place simultaneously in German and English.

The conference – following the 2018 release of Germany's AI Strategy – will go deeper into the debate around ethics and politics of AI in Germany, Europe and beyond. In particular, it will set discussion around article one of the German Basic Law – the promise of the Enlightenment – that "Human dignity is inviolable. To respect and protect it shall be the duty of all state authority."

#AspenAl19 will explore how citizens, developers, governments, companies and civil society can create the proper ethical and political framework to garauntee the immense power of Al and machine learning serves the public and global good.
